





Let's Eat Healthy Nutrition Lessons Program Description

Lessons have been adapted to video delivery format with permission by the Dairy Council of CA in cooperation with the Santa Clara County Public Health and University Cooperative Extension.

7 lessons total that are comprised of 2-4 videos each lesson. The videos are short, topic-based and align to curriculum learning objectives for 4th and 5th grade.

Each lesson has a student workbook video that guides the students on how to complete each student workbook lesson.

The comprehensive series has 19 educational videos, 14 workbook instructional videos, fillable student workbooks, and a quick start guide for the teachers. *Nutrition Pathfinders*, Let's Eat Healthy videos and resources are being added throughout December and January.
