Welcome to the LEAD UP Youth Achievement Program Online Application Form! Thank you for your interest in LEAD UP. The LEAD UP (Leadership, Education, Adolescent Development and Unlimited Potential) Youth Achievement Program is for racial/ethnic minority youth who are invited to participate in the program between 9th grade through the first year of college. The program provides leadership and college preparation supports for youth who really want to achieve in life, beginning with their education. ALL youth who want to participate in LEAD UP must complete either a new or continuing renewal online application by May 10th at 8:00 am. You are required to complete the online application if you are interested in participating in the program as either a: (a) new program participant, or (b) returning current LEAD UP Achiever who would like to continue/renew participation in the program.

Participation in the program includes the following:

Participation in the three-day summer academy at KU! The academy cost is \$170. If you need to subsidize some of the costs, please indicate it in the application as a limited number of partial scholarships may be available.

Participation in online weekly communications (e.g., text messages, emails) provided through the LEAD UP Collaboratory (myleadup.com) including the Achiever 365 blog and other tools.

Participation in monthly LEAD UP Meet Up sessions hosted with the partnering community or school organization who referred you to the program.

As part of completing the online application, you are required to:

Complete all questions in the online application. When you begin the application you'll need to finish. So, make sure you are ready and have some time before you begin the online application. However, if you are not able to complete the application in one go, please follow instructions below to save and return later to your incomplete application:

1. Ensure that you click on the "Save and Return later" button displayed on each page, when you need to exit.

2. A window will pop up with a code that you can use to resume your application process later. Be sure to copy the code for later use.

3. As soon as click on "Close" in the window that displays the code, you will be directed to a page that requests your email ID.

4. Please enter your email ID to receive a link to resume your incomplete application. It is not the same link that you used to start the application process.

Provide well-written responses to the essay questions in the application (make sure you proofread). Submit all attachments that are a required part of the application including your most recent grade card from this school year. You will be required to upload/attach a copy or image of your grade report from the school year, including both fall and spring semesters. (If you recently finished the school year and haven't received your grade card yet, then submit your the grades that you can access from your online school portal.

Parents/Guardians must also complete the LEAD UP Parent/Guardian Consent and Approval Form by the application deadline.
