	<p>Aftan engaged with Julie Thornton, an HR manager, to understand who oversees the policy at KU. Julie responded back and explained that they weren't sure they had capacity to update/improve/better enforce the policy. Strategies include reaching out to UDK since they promote Hookah House, Housing, signage (can we use Pathways funding for signage??). Aftan will ask who can approve tobacco/vaping signage at KU and the cost. Thinks that KU athletics doesn't promote tobacco products and doesn't receive tobacco/vaping funding. NCAA doesn't allow advertising for tobacco products.</p> <p>Aftan reached out to Dr. Holt to follow-up on our discussion from our meeting. We didn't hear back from her yet, so Laura's intern Shonnardo from Baker will go ahead and try to meet with her in person to ask about what the questions on the student health survey are and when the survey will go out and be returned.
